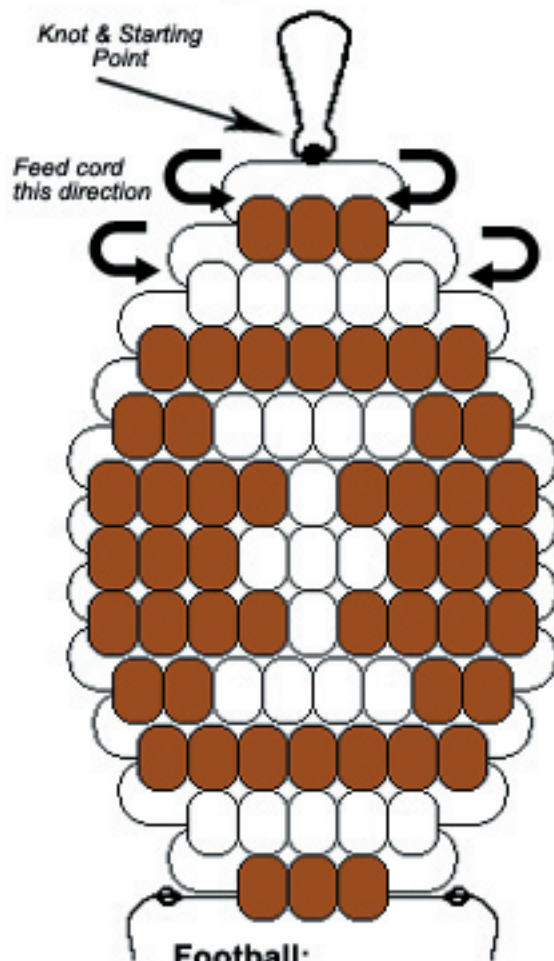
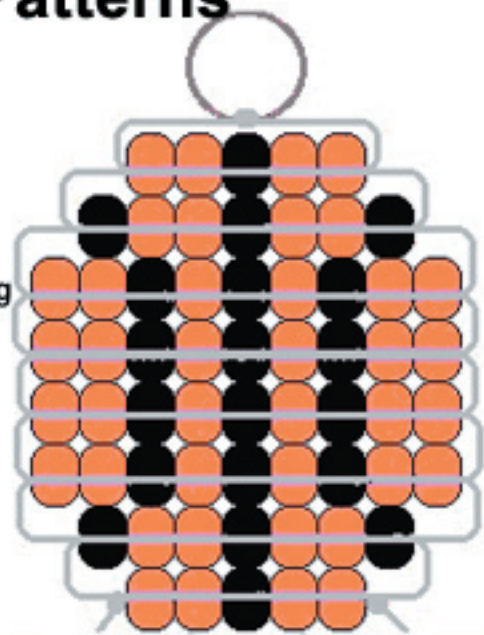


Sports Ball Pony Bead Patterns

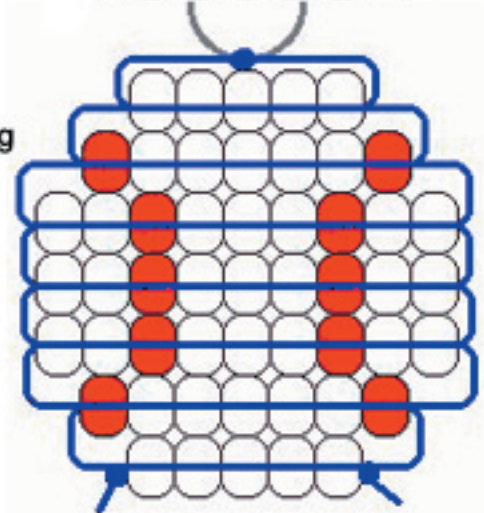


Football:
2 yards cord*
1 lanyard hook or key ring
50 brown pony beads
23 white pony beads

Basketball:
2 yards cord*
1 lanyard hook or key ring
40 orange pony beads
20 black pony beads



Baseball:
2 yards cord*
1 lanyard hook or key ring
41 white pony beads
10 red pony beads



Basic Instructions:

- Fold the cord in half to find the middle. Knot it in the middle on key ring/lanyard.
- Weave the cord through the beads, starting at top and working down to bottom. See the arrows on the football above to get a visual. The cords will pass each other going through the beads and be feed through the opposite direction the next row. See tips about cord size.
- When done double knot the end of cord, you can leave a "cord tail" and finish with more beads or sports ball shaped beads.

Tips:

- you can use any cord or plastic lace, the most popular is rattail. We have both 1mm and 2 mm rattail.
- if the ends of cord fray use a touch of clear nail polish.
- to can also attach a piece of toothpick to end of cord to help with feeding it through.
